The transition is almost seamless, giving the illusion of a single presentation. Here's how to connect PowerPoint presentations together. Before you start, note that both presentations must be in the same folder to link them together. Moving or renaming the second file after the link has been created will cause the slide to break. Connecting two presentations together isn't magic, but it's as simple as inserting and clicking a hyperlink. This trick allows you to insert a link within an object or text from slide A that takes you to a specific slide from slide B while you are still in slide mode. After opening the first presentation and navigating to the slide from which you will connect, select the text or object you want to link to. Click the "OK" button Next, you will be given a list of slides of the presentation you are linking to. Select the slide you want to go to and click "OK." Now you will notice that the path to the file of the second presentation appears in the "Hyperlink To" box Once you are ready, select the "OK" button The hyperlink will now be inserted into the selected text or object.
