There will be no rebirth of the hashtag #OscarsSoWhite this year. In fact, the two executive categories for actors are the most different to today. Riz Ahmed (Sound of Metal), Chadwick Boseman (Ma Rainey's Black Bottom) and Steven Yeun (Minari) are nominated for their main roles along with Anthony Hopkins (The Father) and Gary Oldman (Mank). Ahmed, who is British Pakistani, and Yeun, who is Korean American, are the first two actors of the Asian descent to be named in the category Best actor. In the support category, three black actors — Daniel Kaluuya (Giuda and the Black Messiah), Leslie Odom Jr. (One Night in Miami) and LaKeith Stanfield (Giuda and the Black Messiah) — were named with Sacha Baron Cohen (The Trial of the Chicago 7) and Paul Raci (Sound of Metal). Viola Davis (Ma Rainey's Black Bottom) and Andra Day (The United States vs. Billie Holiday), who play the legends of Ma Rainey and Billie Holiday music respectively, were nominated for the best actress, along with Vanessa Kirby (Pieces of a Woman), Frances McDormand (Nomadland) and Carey Mulligan (Promising Young Woman). The Best Supporting Actress category includes the performer who plays the charismatic grandmother in Minari, Yuh-Jung Youn, as well as Maria Bakalova (Borat Subsequent Moviefilm), Glenn Close (Hillbilly Elegy), Olivia Colman (The Father) and Amanda Seyfried (Mank). The acting categories are not the only ones to show the diversity between the 2021 Oscar nominations. The women directors have made history this year; for the first time, there are two women appointed for the best director — Chloé Zhao (Nomadland) and Emerald Fennell (Promising Young Woman). Zhao is also the first black woman to be named in the direction category. Photo Courtesy: Getty Images Apart from Zhao and Fennell nominations, the directorship category is particularly diversified this year due to the appointment of Korean-American director Isaac Lee Chung (Minari), Danish director Thomas Vinterberg (Another Round) and David Fincher (Mank) complete the direct nominations. The Best Picture award also has its share of diversity this year. Among the producers appointed, there is the Christina Oh of Minari, the first woman always a nomination in this category. And Judas and the Black Messiah became the first film of the whole Black-Product to be named, earning nominations for Shaka King, Charles D. and Ryan Coogler. Mia Neal and Jamika Wilson also made the story, becoming the first black women named for an Oscar in the makeup and hairstyle category for their work in the black background of Ma Rainey. Even with all the historical nominations, there were also a few snobbishing numerous, such as the practice of the lack of practical appointments of DA 5 Blood. The director Spike Lee was not among the nominated filmmakers, nor was actor of thero Lindo. Other notable absences were the lack of inclusion of the black background of Ma Rainey and one night in Miami in the best category of images. Regina King, who directed one night in Miami, was also a director's nomination runner, but did not make the final list. The #oscarssowhite social media hashtag was widely used as a reaction to the 87th Academy Awards in 2015, when not only one color person was named in the execution categories. The omission felt particularly unforgivable due to the exclusion of actor David Oyelowo, who played Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. in the film Selma. The story was repeated in 2016 when all running candidates were again white. Idris Elba in beasts of no nation and Michael B. Jordan in the creed were among black performers snuggled for nominations that year. Following the lack of diversity among its members, in 2016 the Academy Awards implemented a series of measures to diversify its membership and double the number of women and different members by 2020. The Academy announced in June 2020 that it had actually exceeded that goal. And even if this year's nominations seem to be indicative of the Academy learning its lesson and such changes to the inscription that proves valuable, we just have to go back a year for a list of nominations much less different than the current one. It was a year when Jennifer Lopez shone of Hustlers and Awkwafina proved her acting skills in the amerente - not to mention Lupita Nyong' or to show her talent in us. Yet one single black performer, black actress Cynthia Erivo (Harriet), was included among the 20 nominees of acting. That need for greater diversity also applied to the categories of directors, where there were no nominations for Greta Gerwig (small women) or Lulu Wang (the farewell). So, as we applaud this year's historical nominations, I hope for a future of Academy Awards where diversity continues as the norm.
