A LOCI is a Letter of continuous interest. Usually, you send it to inform a school of your interest to participate despite being on the waiting list or waiting. However, do not send a LOCI until you receive a notification that requires action. In other words, don't send a LOCI just because your app is in consideration and you haven't heard anything from a while. Schools can take a long time to make decisions and no news equals bad news. Constant contact the admissions office can be seen as pestering and no one wants that reputation. This advice does not apply if a kind of event causes change in the state of the application. For example, if you receive a new, higher LSAT score, there is no harm in letting the school know! The same would be true if you send a note of thanks for a great interview or school visit. How do you format and insert a LOCI? The LOCI can be written in a literal form or as a standard statement, but it is necessary to enter the identification information in the document. Your name and CAS number must be included at the minimum. Preferably include your address and contact information, even if you have space. Don't forget to include the date. The easiest way to make the letter is to create a Word document and save it as a PDF to preserve formatting. Word can sometimes lose basic formatting if different versions are used in the admission office.
